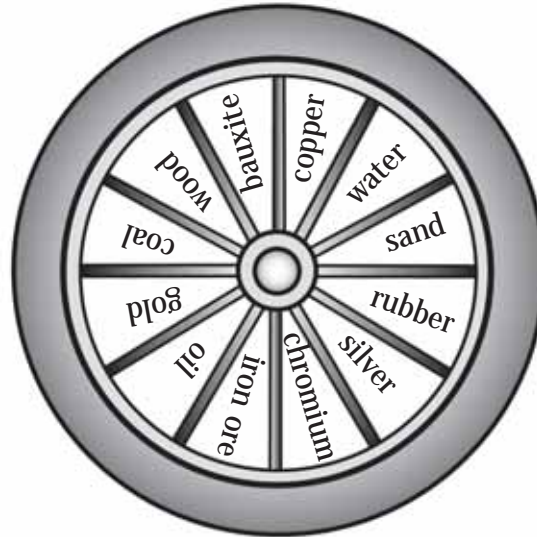




NATURAL RESOURCES KEEP US ROLLING!
